ENCHANTING UNICORN PLATE



MATERIALS

- Plate
- Pencil • Sponge
- Unicorn Pattern (See last page)
 Tissue Paper
 Dark Water-Based Marker
 1 Short Liner Brush
 2 Round Brush
 4 Round Brush

CMM Colors: 62 – Just Blue, 68 – Beachcomber, 03 – Carnation, 05 – Coral Reef, 92 – Ghostly Grape, 31 – Licorice

TIPS

For thinner lines when outlining designs with a liner brush, load the brush up with a little bit of paint at a time. The more paint you put on the brush, the thicker your line will be.
Another key to thinner brush lines is to be mindful of the amount of pressure you put on the liner brush. The lighter you press on the brush, the thinner your line will be.
If you would like full, solid coverage, do three coats of color. Make sure to let it dry between each coat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Before you begin, wipe a damp sponge over the entire plate to remove dust and contaminants.

1. Trace the unicorn pattern onto the tissue paper with a pencil.

2. Place the tissue paper over the plate and trace over the pencil lines with a dark water-based marker. Hold onto the tissue carefully so that the design doesn't shift as you trace.

3. Paint 2-3 coats of Ghostly Grape on the mane and tail.

4. Paint 2-3 coats of Coral Reef on the unicorn horn.

5. Starting at the top of the rainbow, paint 2-3 coats with Beachcomber, Carnation, and then Coral Reef.

6. Paint 3 coats of Just Blue around the design onto the background of the plate. Alternate between the thinner brush for painting around corners and small areas and a larger brush for the more open areas.

7. With a liner brush, carefully outline everything with Licorice.

8. Using the back of the pencil like a stamp, make black dots around the edge of the plate as a border.

9. Leave your plate with your local Color Me Mine studio to be clear glazed and fired. Your ceramic masterpiece will be water and food safe.
