

PATRIOTIC TALAVERA PLATTER

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB40067 Talavera Platter
Small Brush
Fan Brush
Sponge

COLORS

CMM 98- Red Head CMM 2 - Stonewash CMM 62 - Just Blue CMM 64 - Sky Blue CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon CMM 47 - Deep Sea



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use a fan brush to paint one coat of Stonewash all over the top of the platter, making sure to get it into all of the crevices.
- 2. Allow to dry for a couple of minutes.
- 3. Use a damp sponge to wipe off the Stonewash from the top of the plate, this will leave it only in the crevices.
- 4. Water down the remaining colors with 50% water to 50% paint. We are going to fill in the sections with one heavy coat of color. To do this, load up your brush with a generous amount of paint. Set the paint down on the section and lightly move the paint around to fill the section, adding more paint as needed.
- 5. Starting from the inside of the plate and working out, fill in each section with the desired color following the instructions in step 4. Only one heavy coat is needed.

TIPS

- When wiping off the Stonewash, rinse your sponge often to help you remove the paint more effectively.
- By watering down the paint you'll only need one generous coat of each color.
- We are not brushing on the paint like you would traditionally, this will create streaks. Instead apply a blob of paint and scoot it around with the end of the brush, applying more paint as needed to fill in one heavy layer.
