

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects

ROLLER BLADE BEACH TRAVEL MUG



MATERIALS

CCX110 Tall Travel Cup
Detail Brush
Liner Brush
Fan Brush
NCR Pattern
Red Pen

COLORS

CMM 16 - Chiffon
CMM 86 - Pretty In Pink
CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 7- Blush
CMM 46 - Sunny Side Up
CMM 17 - Margarita
CMM 31 - Licorice



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use a fan brush to apply 3 coats of Chiffon to the entire outside of the mug. Allow the mug to dry for a few minutes.
- 2. Trace on palm trees going around the mug using the NCR pattern. Trace over the palm trees with a red pen, pressing firmly as you go. Vary the heights of the palm trees as you go.
- 3. Use a liner brush to apply 2 coats of Pretty in Pink to each of the palm trees. Allow the trees to dry for a few minutes.
- 4. Trace on the words and roller blades using the NCR pattern. Trace over the pattern with a red pen pressing firmly as you go. Before you remove the pattern, hold the corner of the pattern down with your finger and peel the paper back. Ensure that you've gotten all of the lines traced on before you remove the pattern.
- 5. Use a detail brush to apply a generous coat of Blush to the words.
- 6. To fill in the design we are going to use a method called "Drop & Fill". First we are going to thin down the colors. We are going to mix 50% water to 50% paint to the following colors: Snowflake, Pretty In Pink, Blush, Sunny Side Up, Margarita.
- 7. To fill each section in we are going load up the brush with the watered down paint and drop the paint into the section we are filling in. Then, use the tip of the brush to gently move the paint around. We will only need to do one coat of this to get a solid section.
- 8. Fill in each section as follow:
 - a.top loop and tongue: Pretty In Pink
 - b. liner: Snowflake
 - c. buckle, laces, and outside of wheels: Blush
 - d. top section of boot and bottom piece above the wheels: Margarita
 - e. main section of boot and inside of wheels: Sunny Side Up
- 9. Finally thin down Licorice paint by adding 50% water to 50% paint. Use a liner brush to sweep thin, broken lines around the design. We aren't going for a solid line around everything, just accents here and there.

TIPS

- The harder you press on the brush, the heavier the lines will be. If you want a thin line, use the tip of the brush and very gentle pressure.
- The roller blade pattern will cover some of the palm trees. If desired, you could trace on the rollerblades and trace the palm trees around it.
