

PUMPKIN PIE PUN PLATE

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB21427 Coupe Salad Plate

NCR Pattern

Red Pen

Liner Brush

Medium Round Brush

Fan Brush

Yellow Sponge Quarter

COLORS

CMM 72 - Sahara

CMM 12 - Mocha Java

CMM 73 - Honeycomb

CMM 18 - Pumpkin Pie

CMM 67 - Snowflake

CMM 15 - Mississippi Mud

CMM 42 - Cranberry Sauce



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Thin down Sahara by adding 50% water to 50% paint. Load up the fan brush and sweep it back and forth across the top of the plate. Add a second layer.
- 2. Thin down Mocha Java by adding 50% water to 50% paint. Dip the medium brush into the paint. Pull the bristles back and flick the paint on the top of the plate. Allow the plate to dry.
- 3. Trace on the NCR pattern to the plate. Use a red pen to firmly trace over all of the lines. Before you remove the pattern, hold it in place on the corner and peel back the pattern to check and see if you've traced on all of the lines.
- 4. Fill in the crust with 3 coats of Honeycomb using the medium brush.
- 5. Next, paint in the orange part of the pie with 3 coats of Pumpkin Pie.
- 6. Use a detail brush to apply 3 coats of Snowflake to the whipped cream.
- 7. Thin down Mississippi Mud with 50% water to 50% paint. Use a liner brush to outline the design.
- 8. When the design is dry, use a detail brush to add in the lettering in Cranberry Sauce.
- 9. To paint the edge, dip the side of the sponge into Pumpkin Pie. Tap off the excess paint onto a paper towel. Gently swipe the sponge on the edge of the plate to create a rim. Allow the first coat to dry and repeat.

TIPS

- The harder you push on the brush, the heavier the line will be. When you're using the detail and liner brush, use the tip of the brush and very light pressure.
- Make sure to tap off the excess paint from the sponge to control the line of paint.
