

ICED APPLE CIDER COFFEE JAR



MATERIALS

DB31220 Mason Jar NCR Pattern Red Pen Liner Brush Detail Brush Medium Brush Fan Brush

COLORS

CMM 12 – Mocha Java CMM 13 – Cinnamon Stick CMM 73 – Honeycomb CMM 88 – Vanilla Bean CMM 67 – Snowflake CMM 30 – Red Rock CMM 29 – Grasshopper CMM 98 – Red Head CMM 27 – Kiwi

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use a fan brush to paint a wide band of Vanilla Bean around the jar. Start two inches under the threads and end an inch away from the bottom. Apply a generous second layer.
- 2. While the Vanilla is still wet, apply Red Rock to the base of the jar and work it up and allow it to overlap with the Vanilla. To blend them together, dip the brush in water and brush back and forth between the two colors. Repeat for 2 more layers.
- 3. Starting under the threads of the jar, apply Cinnamon Stick about an inch down. Repeat for a second layer.
- 4. While the Cinnamon Stick is still wet, use Honeycomb to paint from the Cinnamon Stick to the Vanilla Bean. Allow the colors to blend and overlap. You may need to apply more Vanilla Bean for the colors to overlap. Repeat for a second layer.
- 5. Paint the threads on the jar with 2 coats of Snowflake.
- 6. To create the drips, water down Red Rock and Honeycomb by adding 50% water to 50% paint. Lightly load a liner brush with the desired color and allow it to drip on the side of the mug. If you feel it's too heavy, lightly brush over it with a wet brush to diffuse. Allow the mug to dry.
- 7. Trace on the circle logo pattern to side of the jar. Use a red pen to firmly trace over all of the lines except for the letters. Before you remove the pattern, hold it in place on the corner and peel back the pattern to check and see if you've traced on all of the lines.
- 8. Fill in the circle on the logo design with 3 coats of Grasshopper.
- 9. Use a detail brush to fill in the apple with 3 coats of Red Head.
- 10. Fill in the stem with one generous coat of Mocha Java, and the leaf with one generous coat of Kiwi.
- 11. Use the NCR logo pattern and line it up on the green circle. Use a pen to trace on the letters. Instead of outlining the letters, color them in on the paper pattern with the pen. This will make an easier pattern to paint in.
- 12. Use a detail brush to fill in the letters with 2 coats of Snowflake.

TIPS

- The harder you push on the brush, the heavier the line will be. When you're using the liner brush, use the tip of the brush and very light pressure.
- Colors blend together better when they're both wet. So when you're trying to get the colors to blend, make sure both are wet. You can also use a little water in the brush to help them blend.
