

FRANKENSTEIN COOKIE MUG

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



## **MATERIALS**

DB32787 Cookies & Milk Mug
NCR Pattern
Red Pen
Liner Brush
Small Round Brush
Medium Round Brush
Yellow Sponge Quarter

## **COLORS**

CMM 27 - Kiwi
CMM 7 - Blush
CMM 22 - Gecko Green
CMM 44 - Battleship
CMM 31 - Licorice
CMM 67 - Snowflake



## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Sponge the outside of the mug with both Gecko Green and Kiwi. Dip the sponge in paint, alternating between the two greens and allowing the colors to overlap as you tap the sponge on the mug.
- 2. Use a medium paint brush to paint the inside of the mouth with 3 coats of Blush.
- 3. When the outside of the mug is dry, trace on the NCR pattern to the front of the mug. Use a red pen to firmly trace over the pattern. Before you remove the pattern, hold it in place on the corner and peel back the pattern to check and see if you've traced on all of the lines. Continue to trace the hair on each side of the mug.
- 4. Paint the hair and the inside of the mug with 3 coats of Licorice.
- 5. Use a liner brush to paint in the details on the face with 1–2 coats of Licorice. Add on scars anywhere on the mug that you'd like them.
- 6. Paint the handle of the mug with 3 coats of Battleship using a medium brush.
- 7. Finally, dip the handle of the brush into Snowflake. Tap the handle of the brush onto the eyes to create the highlights.

## TIPS

- Allow the greens to overlap as you sponge them onto the outside of the mug to allow them to blend.
- The harder you press on the brush the heavier the lines will be. When you're adding on the facial features, use gentle pressure to achieve thinner lines.
