

# FINGERPRINT CUPCAKE PLATTER

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



### **MATERIALS**

CMM 2004 Cupcake Platter
Liner Brush
Medium Brush
Writing Bottle

## **COLORS**

CMM 31 - Licorice
CMM 98 - Red Head
CMM 57 - Squash Blossom
CMM 46 - Sunny Side Up
CMM 27 - Kiwi
CMM 85 - Oceanscape
CMM 41 - Perfectly Purple



#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Use a medium brush to apply 3 generous coats of Red Head to the cherry on the top of the cupcake.
- 2. Paint the stripes with 3 coats of paint alternating between Red Head, Squash Blossom, Sunny Side Up, Kiwi, Oceanscape, and Perfectly Purple.
- 3. For the fingerprints:
- Brush a layer of paint to the fingertip and press onto the top part of the cupcake using one of the colors listed in Step 2.
- Use a pencil to write the child's name next to the print.
- 4. To apply the names, use a detail writing bottle with Licorice to write the name next to that child's fingerprint.
- 5. If desired, write the class/organization name on the back of the platter with the year.

#### **TIPS**

- Three coats of paint will give you a solid color.
- For the writing bottle, only fill the bottle 1/2 way to avoid it coming out too fast. This will help with smaller writing.
- Get the writer bottle flowing on a paper towel before you write on your piece. This will work out any air and sputtering that might occur.
