

RETRO KITCHEN MIXING BOWLS

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



MATERIALS

DB31507 Small Mixing Bowl
DB31508 Medium Mixing Bowl
DB31509 Large Mixing Bowl
Large Brush
Fan Brush
Liner Brush
1.5" Sponge Stippler
3/4" Sponge Stippler
1/2" Sponge Stippler

COLORS

CMM 98 - Red Head CMM 55 - Sea Mist CMM 3 - Carnation CMM 14 - Gum Drop



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Paint the inside of the bowls with 3 generous coats of Gum Drop with a fan brush.
- 2. Use a fan brush to paint the outside of the bowls with 3 coats of paint in the following colors:
- Small Carnation
- Medium Sea Mist
- Large Red Head
- 3. Use the 1.5" Sponge Stippler to apply the large dots around the large bowl using Gum Drop.
- 4. Use the 3/4" Sponge Stippler to apply the next row of dots around the large bowl using Gum Drop.
- 5. Then, use the 1/2" Sponge Stipper to apply the smallest row of dots around the large bowl using Gum Drop.
- 6. When the dots are dry, apply 2 more coats of Gum Drop using a small brush.
- 7. For the small brush, use the 3/4" Sponge Stipper to apply the first row of dots around the small bowl using Gum Drop.
- 8. Then, use the 1/2" Sponge Stippler to apply the next row of dots around the small bowl using Gum Drop.
- 9. Use the handle end of the 1/2" Sponge Stippler to apply the smallest row of dots around the small bowl.
- 10. When the dots are dry, apply 2 more coats of Gum Drop using a small brush.

TIPS

- Applying 3 generous coats will give you a solid color.
- When making the dots, dip the sponge into paint and tap out the excess to get a more even circle.
