


# RETRO KITCHEN PIE PLATE



### MATERIALS

CCX508 Pie Plate Liner Brush Fan Brush Small Brush Medium Brush NCR Bird Pattern Pen

### COLORS

CMM 19 – Banana Boat CMM 98 – Red Head CMM 55 – Sea Mist CMM 18 – Pumpkin Pie CMM 59 – Turquoise CMM 3 – Carnation CMM 14 – Gum Drop CMM 15 – Mississippi Mud

#### INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Paint the inside of the pie plate with 3 generous coats of Sea Mist, leaving the edge of the plate unpainted.
- 2. Apply 3 generous coats of Red Head to the edge of the pie plate.
- 3. Allow the plate to dry for a few minutes before applying the NCR pattern.
- 4. To apply the pattern, cut the paper down so that you can fit the pattern into the center of the plate.
- 5. Use a pen and firmly trace over all of the lines. Before you remove the pattern, hold it in place with one finger and then peel it back to see if the entire pattern is traced on.
- 6. Next, fill in the pattern using 3 generous coats of paint using the following colors:
- Bird bodies: Carnation
- Bird wings: Pumpkin Pie
- Flower centers: Banana Boat
- Flowers: Red Head
- Leaves: Gum Drop and Turquoise
- 7. Use a liner brush to apply the legs on the birds.
- 8. Dip the back of a detail brush in Mississippi Mud and lightly press on the bird to make the eye.
- 9. Flip the pie plate over and apply 3 generous coats of Red Head to the back.

## TIPS

- Applying 3 generous coats will give you a solid color.
- Wait until the background paint is dry before tracing the pattern.
- To apply the pattern, press firmly with a pen as you trace over the outlines of the pattern.
