

SEASONAL PRINTS DREIDEL PLATE



MATERIALS

C91390 Star of David Plate Fan Brush Detail Brush Liner Brush Yellow Sponge Quarter Pencil or Water-Based Marker Writing Bottle

COLORS

CMM 11- Blue Lagoon CMM 43 - Saffire CMM 19 - Banana Boat CMM 47 - Deep Sea

INSTRUCTIONS

This piece can be made with any combination of colors or number of prints. Below are the instructions for how this exact piece was made, but make it your own to fit your needs!

- 1. Use a fan brush to apply a generous layer of Deep Sea paint to the right hand.
- 2. Place the hand on the plate, slightly to the right of center, with the thumb pointing up (not out to the side).
- 3. While pushing the hand down, move the elbow up so that the arm is perpendicular to the plate. Then press on the back of the hand. This will help get the print flat and can help avoid a blank spot on the palm's print.
- 4. Sketch on a dreidel around the hand. Or, you can trace the dreidel pattern attached.
- 5. Thin down Saffire paint with 50% water to 50% paint. Use a liner brush to apply the paint to the lines on the pattern. For the letters, use 2-3 coats.
- 6. Using the picture as a guide, use a liner brush to apply the "movement" lines next to the dreidel with one coat of Deep Sea.
- 7.Use the writer bottle with Blue Lagoon paint to apply the words and the name.
- 8. Dip the sponge in Banana Boat paint and tap off the excess onto a paper towel. Tap the sponge around the edge of the plate to create a textured border.

TIPS

- When sketching in pencil for the writing, gently rub back and forth over the pencil lines to remove excess graphite. This will make it easier to write on top of it.
- For the writing bottle, only fill the bottle 1/2 way to avoid it coming out too fast. This will help with smaller writing.
- Get the writer bottle flowing on a paper towel before you write on your piece. This will work out any air and sputtering that might occur.
